

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY: Your County Personnel and Human Services Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the United Way of Southwest Michigan has identified parent education programs as a strategy to address the identified target area of Education in the 2022-2025 funding period; and

WHEREAS, the Berrien County Health Department's Positive Parenting Program (Triple-P) provides evidence-based parenting education and support; and


WHEREAS, the Berrien County Health Department (BCHD) desires to contract with the United Way for the 2022-2025 Funding Cycle in order to continue providing Triple P interventions in Berrien County; and

WHEREAS, funding for this grant agreement is in the amount of \$28,000 annually (reduction from prior funding cycle amount of \$50,000) for the Triple-P Program over a three-year grant period of July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2025. The funding helps to meet the 50% match requirement of the Children's Trust Fund and supports operational expenditures including staff time, travel expenses, and necessary supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health endorses the approval of this funding agreement, pending approval of Corporate Counsel.


